## **When: League Play Begins Wednesday, May 6 2026**

**Sign Up:** You may join the league at any time during the season with at least one week's notice.

**Greens fees:** May be payed through club membership, cabin cards, or league specific cabin cards

**Cost:** Annual League Membership Fee is \$55.00. There are additional games for up to \$20.00. Please see the sign-up form at the bottom for more information on cost structure. Funds are used for weekly payout of prizes and proxies. As in prior years, we will alternate each week with Individual and Team Events.

**Rain Delay Protocol:** In the event of rain or unfavorable weather, the club will send out an email at 7am the morning of the round to update the league on whether the course will be staying open or if the round has to be canceled. In the case we decide there are not enough golfers for a certain event, because of the weather, we will have an individual style game ready that still allows those willing to play an opportunity to compete

### **Individual League Events:**

We will divide the flights into equal numbers of players. Pro Shop credit will be provided to first, second, and third best scores in each flight. We also provide Pro Shop credit for weekly Low Net.

### **Team Events:**

Payout will be made to the two or three best team scores (dependent on number of players).

### **Special Season Long Tournaments:**

Special Flights, Shoot Out

League Championship Tournament: Qualification requires FIVE (5) 18-hole League events in the 2026 season.

**Weekly Sign-Up with Golf Genius:** Each week (Wednesday at 12pm) you will receive an email with an invitation to sign up to play golf for the following week, and you will need to select "Playing" or "Not playing". You will then receive a "donotreply" message from Golf Genius confirming your choice, that will give you the option to change your reply. There is no need to reply unless you are changing your reply.

**Whitefish Cup:** runs from **June 3, 2026 through August 19, 2026**. There is no charge for this event.

Entry is automatic to all paid League members.

All league members will receive 25 participation points for every event they play. 1<sup>st</sup> place 100 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place 75 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> place 50 points.

### **Handicaps:**

All members must have a USGA GHIN handicap. If you do not have a USGA GHIN handicap index, you may sign up with the Whitefish Golf Club for your handicap to be established prior to playing in your first event in the League. Three 18-hole scores are required to establish a handicap. You can play anywhere to establish the three rounds, as long as those rounds are recorded in GHIN.

### **Shotgun Starts:**

All events in 2026 will be a shotgun start unless noted otherwise on the schedule. Sign-up will be on-line by email invitation to those who have paid their dues for the season. For Opening Day, we will send an invitation to all members from the 2025 Season. Sign up opens one week prior to the league day and will close by NOON ON MONDAY before the league event on Wednesday.

**Tee Assignments:** All Golfers may choose whether they are going to play from the red or gold tees. A decision must be finalized by the second round of the year. Please note, to be eligible to win the league championship, it will be required that you play from the **Gold** tees during the Championship. Golfers may move from the Red tees to the gold tees for this event.

### **Rules:**

USGA Rules are in effect at all times. Summer rules apply at all times unless course conditions warrant otherwise.

Pace of Play: For the playing enjoyment of all members, each league member is expected to play at a pace to afford a maximum of a 4-hour 15-minute round.
