2026 Whitefish Women's 9-Hole League Information

League Dates for 2026: League play will begin on Wednesday May 6th and goes through Wednesday September 23rd, 2026.

Whitefish Cup: This season, we're excited to introduce a FedEx Cup-style points system for the Women's League. Points will be awarded based on how you place within your flight each week, as well as for participation, with the goal of encouraging consistent play and adding an extra layer of fun and excitement throughout the season. First place in each flight will receive 100 points, second place will receive 75 points, and third place will receive 50 points, while every golfer who participates that week will receive 25 points.

League Membership Form: Included with this email is a 2026 membership sign-up form. Please mail or email your completed form to Whitefish Golf Club by April 1, 2026, using the address listed on the form or cwill@whitefishgolf.com. Payment may be made by mailing a check, paying in the pro shop, or, for club members, charging your member account. If you know anyone who may be interested in joining the league, please have them contact the golf shop at 218 543 4900 or email cwill@whitefishgolf.com.

2026 Dues: Dues for our 2026 Season are \$35. This covers weekly prizes for regular Wednesday League events, prizes for weekly low net, proxies, chip-ins, and for our Championship Tournament.

Season Long Shootout: All league members are eligible for the shoot-out.

Qualifying scores will be based on the lowest 9-hole net scores during league play. The lowest 20 net scoring players will qualify for a 9-hole shoot-out contest. The cut-off date for qualifying scores is August 6th. The Shootout is scheduled for AUGUST 13TH 2026

Handicaps: 9 Hole League rules require all golfers to establish a handicap through GHIN. Handicaps may be purchased from Whitefish Golf Club or any other clubs. If you are purchasing through Whitefish, the 2026 handicap (GHIN) fee is \$45.00

Rain Delay Protocol: In the event of rain or unfavorable weather, the club will send out an email at **8am** the morning of the round to update the league on whether the course will be staying open or if the round has to be canceled. In the case we decide there are not enough golfers for a certain event because of the weather we will have an individual style game ready that still gives those who attend a chance to earn points for the Whitefish cup.

Weekly Golf Sign-Up with Golf Genius: Each week (Wednesday at 12pm) you will receive an email with an invitation to sign up to play golf for the following week, and you will need to select "Playing" or "Not playing". You will then receive a "donotreply" message from Golf Genius confirming your choice, that will give you the option to change your reply. There is no need to reply unless you are changing your reply.

If you haven't received an invitation for golf by noon on the Friday before, please check your email's Spam folder before contacting the pro shop.

Members will be notified by Monday at 12:00pm via email of their tee time and playing partners.

If you must cancel golf: Please do so before 11:00 am on Monday using Golf Genius, or by notifying the pro shop.
